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Regular General Meeting  
March 3, 2018

The regular meeting of the North East Ohio Regional Quilt Council convened at 10:00 AM at the Christ Church Episcopal in Hudson, President Jan Hittle presiding. All elected officers were present. The meeting was hosted by the Memory Makers Guild.

President Hittle introduced members of the board who were present, and recognized Past President, Cindy Casciato.

The Minutes of the October, 2017, General Meeting were approved as printed.

The Treasurer's report was filed for audit.

Vice President, Beth Headings, called the roll of the Guilds present. 80 members represented 19 guilds. She distributed the new membership brochure.
