# Meet NEORQC Member Shop Imagine That is more



The shop was born out of COVID. Megan Sorn and her Mother saw that people were fading without the much-needed social interaction.

The pair has a small quilting studio named Imagine That Designs LLC, in the Westpark, Kamm's Corners neighborhood of Cleveland. It is their happy place. Megan does custom quilting and her Mother creates uniquely pieced quilts. They would have been happy to do that for the rest of their lives but they saw a need for Community after COVID. Sewing had always been an emotionally healing activity so they wanted to share that with the people around them. A church group that met at their studio gave their input, love and support when Megan and her Mother decided to expand into a larger storefront just down the street in September 2021. "Recognizing the good fruit that has come from our endeavors, for us and others, Imagine That & More is our way of re-potting God's blessing, and expanding, so we all have the space and inspiration to grow," said Megan.

First and foremost, *Imagine That & More* is a creative space for the fabric arts. The goal is to build a community that encourages people to grow their creative skills so that they can accomplish their dreams. They believe in buying local, carrying locally-made products and working with other businesses and schools to do charitable community events. These events allow seasoned sewists to share their skills with newbies.

The focus on community, bonding, and learning more than products sets them apart from other shops with:

- Large cutting and pressing stations
- Open studio times every day (free on Fridays)
- Couches for yarn and hand-stitching
- Specialty and project-related lines of fabrics and notions
- Dealers and repair technicians for APQS (American Professional Quilting Systems) long arm machines
- 3 long arm & 1 sit-down long arm machine for rent
- Concierge service to fully load your quilt, wind your bobbins & adjust the tension so customers can come in and quilt right away without any fuss
- Monthly Farm Girl Club, an extensive line of Lori Holt fabrics & projects
- Wool fabrics and kits for applique with Ohio-based Sue Spargo, as one of their major suppliers
- Locally hand-dyed yarns plus knitting & crocheting classes and a bi-weekly Yarn Parties
- For meetings, special events or workshops, inquire for the details.
